# Message from the Secretary General of Scientific Research Council (SRC)

It is my great privilege to share this message on behalf of the Scientific Research Council (SRC) of University College of Bahrain (UCB). At UCB, we are deeply committed to promoting high-quality and ethically grounded research, in alignment with the Kingdom of Bahrain's Vision 2030 and the National Research Strategy. Our research agenda is fully integrated with UCB's strategic objectives, ensuring that our scholarly activities contribute meaningfully to social, business, economic, technological, and sustainability challenges facing the Kingdom of Bahrain and the wider region.

The academic year 2024-25 marked a milestone for UCB's research journey. We proudly hosted the 2<sup>nd</sup> UCB International Conference on Business and Innovation Technology (UCB-ICBIT 2025) in May 2025. The conference received an overwhelming response, with 233 scientific papers submitted, and 111 papers accepted from 36 countries. Notably, UCB faculty members, students, and alumni participated actively as presenters, an achievement that reflects our mission to nurture research culture across all academic levels.

Equally important was the success of the 2<sup>nd</sup> UCB Research Day in April 2025, which showcased undergraduate student poster presentations, a research dialogue on artificial intelligence, and the Three-Minute Thesis (3MT) competition for MBA students. These initiatives demonstrated UCB's commitment to building a vibrant and inclusive research ecosystem that bridges theory with practice.

The UCB Research Report 2024-25 provides an overview of our faculty's scholarly contributions, including journal articles, book chapters, books, conference papers, and awards. The report also highlights research activities throughout academic year 24-25, reflecting both academic excellence and social impact. In collaboration with the Community Engagement Committee, SRC also organized capacity-building workshops on "questionnaire design and development" for faculty, students and external stakeholders, further strengthening research mentorship and skills development.

I am particularly pleased to report a remarkable growth in research output. In AY 2024-25, UCB faculty produced 97 major research publications, a significant increase from 43 publications in AY 2023-24. These 97 research outputs comprise of 21 journal articles, 28 book chapters, 5 books, and 43 conference papers during the year. This upward improvement is a testament to the dedication and perseverance of our faculty and students.

As we enter AY 2025-26, the SRC reaffirms its commitment to advancing UCB's research culture, enhancing collaboration, and ensuring that our contributions resonate with Bahrain's national priorities and the global academic community. Together, we aspire to strengthen UCB's position as a beacon of innovative and impactful research, fostering the Kingdom's knowledge-based economy.

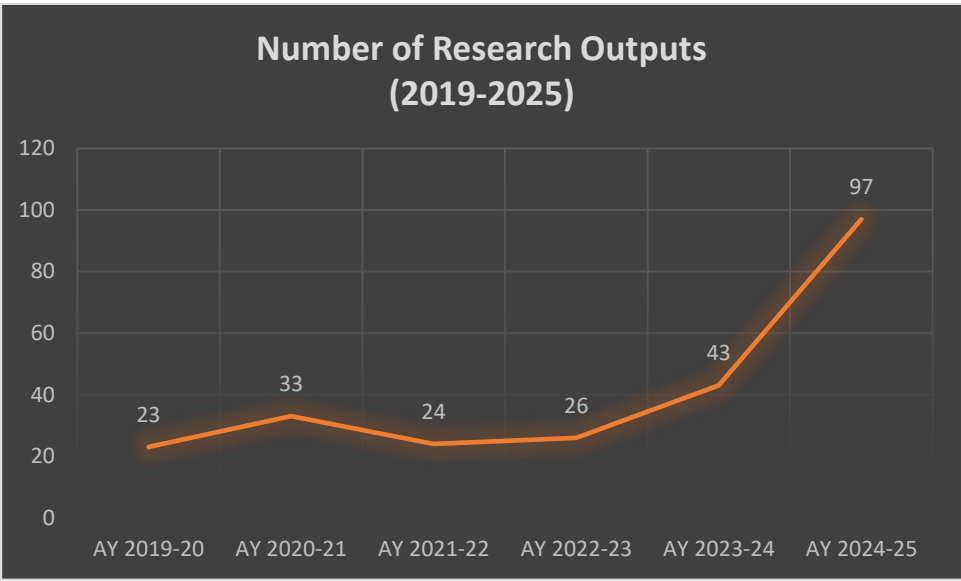

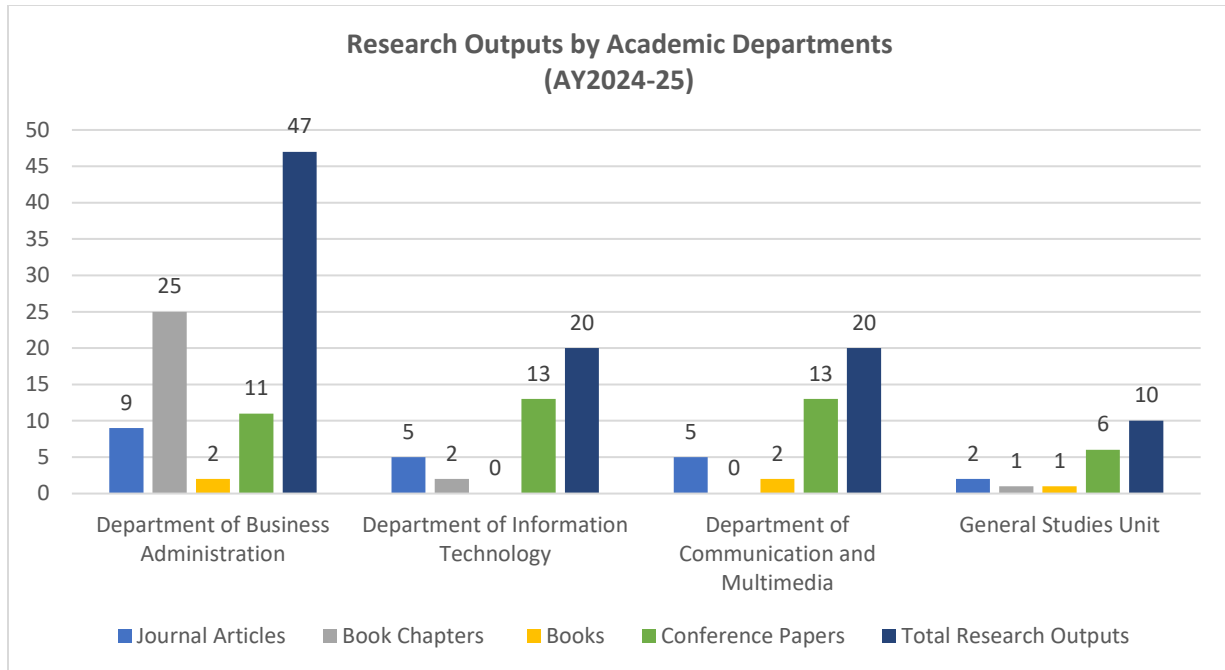

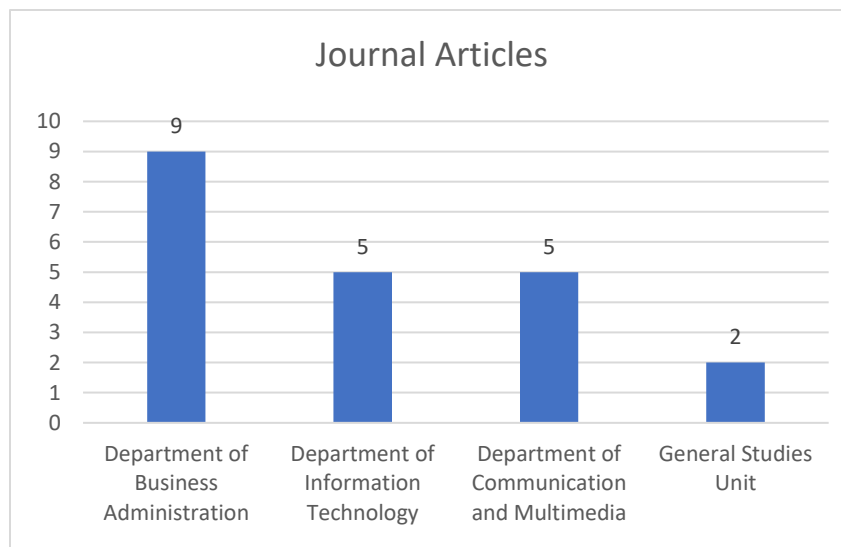

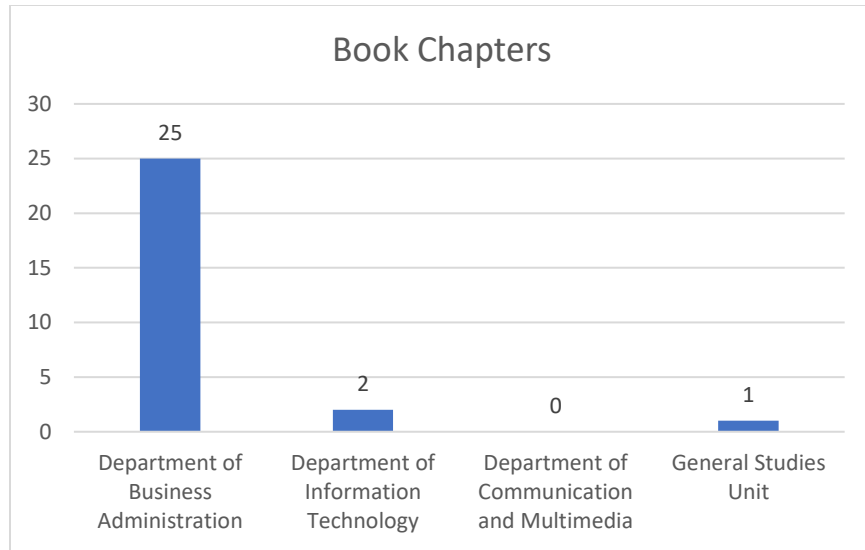


**Figure 2.**  
Research Outputs by Academic Departments in AY2024-25

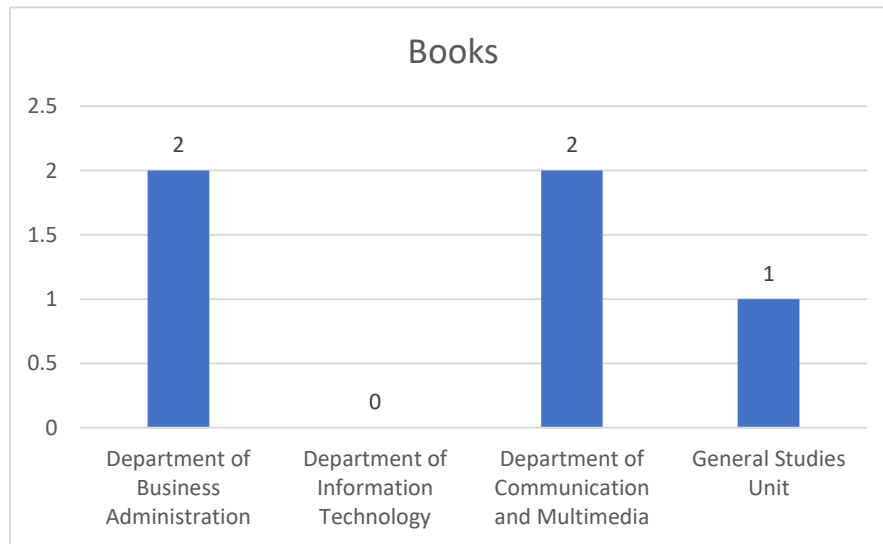


**Figure 3.**  
Published journal articles in AY24-25

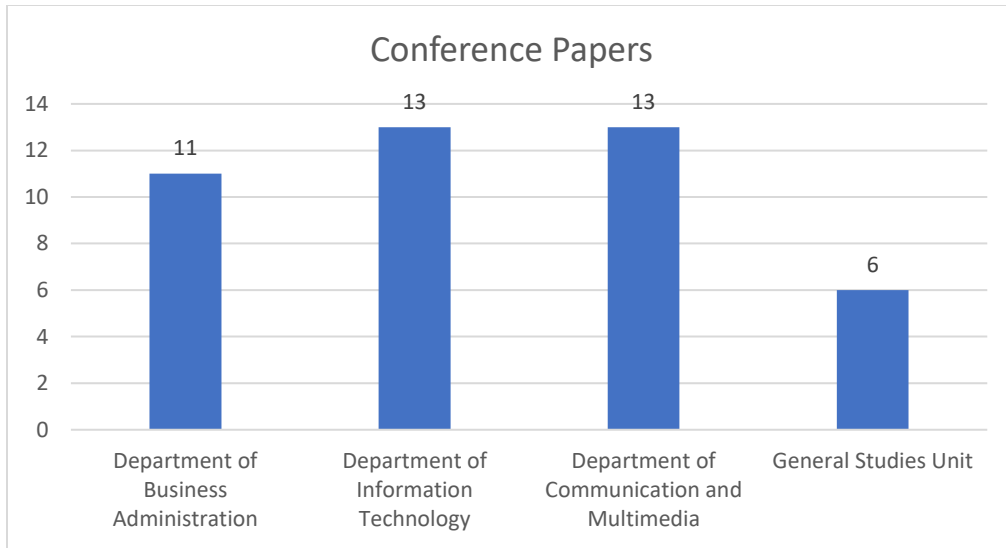




**Figure 4.**

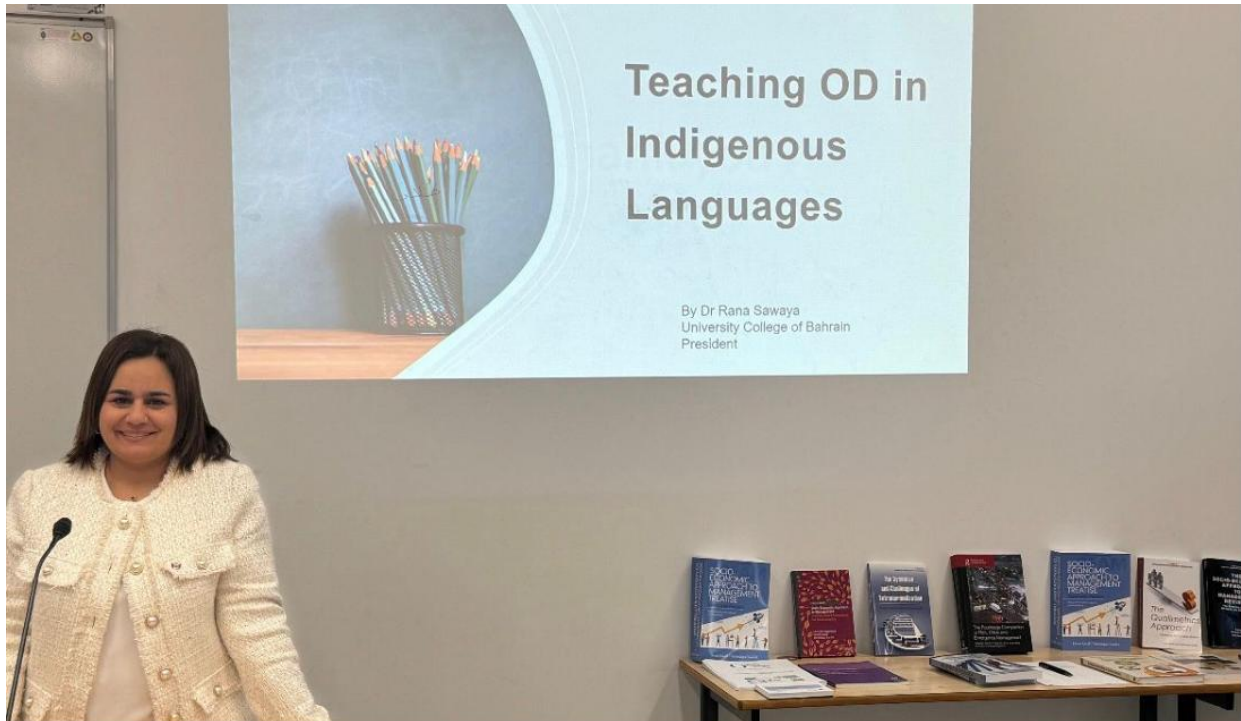

Prof. Nandita Sengupta, Head of the Department of Information Technology at University College of Bahrain (UCB), proudly represented UCB at the prestigious IEEE ITIKD2025 International Conference, hosted by Ahlia University on 15th April 2025.

She presented her research paper titled “*Enhanced Intrusion Detection System for IoMT Devices Using Improved Human Evolutionary Optimization Algorithm and Tabular Transformers*”. The paper showcases innovative approaches to strengthening cybersecurity on the Internet of Medical Things (IoMT) through advanced optimization and deep learning techniques.



Dr. Yusuf Janahi, Vice President for Academic Affairs and Quality, represented UCB at the Business and Technology Conference hosted by the University of Edinburgh, where he presented how the Kingdom of Bahrain is harnessing digital innovation to advance environmental sustainability.

Dr. Yusuf Janahi highlighted several national initiatives, including the Bahrain eGovernment Portal, which provides over 400 online services, significantly reducing paper consumption and lowering carbon emissions. He also emphasized the impact of smart electricity meters, contributing to a targeted 6% reduction in energy consumption by 2025, as well as real-time leak detection systems that improve water conservation.
